LEOPARDOS & FLAMINGOS

PANDAS

- DAILY NEEDS: Disposable diapers, baby wipes, & diaper ointment
- · Bibs daily in diaper bag
- 1 Silicone style bib with crumb pocket
- Formula or Breast milk
- 5 Clean Bottles for the day (each day go home) labeled
- Cereal/Baby Food (Gerbers) for the day as child nutritional needs increase
- 3 Complete changes of clothes (replenished if sent home soiled, seasonally appropriate)
- · Diaper bag daily for take home items
- 2 Boxes of Tissue
- 2 Tubes disinfecting wipes (Clorox wipes)
- 1 Box of gallon & quart size ziplock bags

KOALAS

- Walking babies need a nap mat / kindermat (washable or plastic)
- Note: Once babies are on table food, center will provide food items, it is suggested
 you continue to send Gerbers until they are fully on table Food.
- Diaper bag daily for take home items
- Diapers, wipes, and ointment always as needed
- · 2 Boxes of tissue
- 2 Tubes disinfecting wipes (Clorox wipes)
- · 1 Silicone style bib with crumb pocket
- 1 Box of Gallon & Quart size ziplock bags
- 2 hard top sippy-cup or straw cups daily (take home to wash)
- 2 Complete changes of clothes (replenish as needed)

PERICOS, CONEJOS & JIRAFAS

- 2 Complete changes of clothes (replenish if used)
- 1 Pack jumbo/chubby crayons
- 1 set Crayola watercolors (Conejos & Jirafas only)
- 1 Bottle Elmer's School-glue
- 1 Pack construction paper (multi color or pick a color)
- 1 Pack glue sticks (2-4)
- 8 Count washable markers broad tip (Jirafas only)
- 1 Mini dry erase lap board for kids (Jirafas only)
